WHAT ARE THE FACTS?

Cis and trans women and girls are underrepresented in HIV clinical research. limiting their options for HIV prevention and treatment.

1.5 MILLION New HIV Diagnosis Worldwide in 2021

49% are cisgender women and girls

14x greater chance for transgender women than cisgender women

Women of color are disproportionately affected by HIV and receive greater rates of new HIV diagnosis
