A RING FOR PREVENTION

Let's put a ring on it! A <u>monthly vaginal ring</u> may soon become the first biomedical HIV prevention method designed specifically for cisgender women to be approved for use. Not diamonds, but the dapivirine ring is a girl's best friend!





A SHOT FOR PREVENTION

A bimonthly injection works to prevent HIV! To the more than <u>550 transgender women</u> and <u>3,200</u> <u>cisgender women</u> who participated in these studies, we have you to thank!

THE REPRIEVE STUDY

The largest randomized HIV study to date has begun reporting results! <u>Find out</u> what we're learning about the health of people living with HIV, including the more than 2,400 women, transgender, and gender non- conforming study participants.



TRANSGENDER WOMEN

Two major research networks are launching their very first studies designed exclusively for transgender women! Learn more about the <u>I Am study</u>, and stay tuned for the "Get it Right" study. Both studies are

looking at gender-affirming hormones and HIV.

HIV VACCINE RESEARCH

Women rock! "Imbokodo" is a Zulu word meaning "rock," and it's also the name of <u>an HIV vaccine study</u> with 2,600 cisgender women in 5 African countries. Keep your eye on this important study!
