SUBJ: ACTG GCAB Community: Response to COVID-19 Pandemic, CAB Site Meetings and June Annual Meeting

As you know, the COVID-19 pandemic is evolving rapidly, creating a significant public health risk that has disrupted many aspects of daily life worldwide.

 WILL SUSPEND ALL IN-PERSON MEETINGS IMMEDIATELY MOVING FORWARD
- Virtual meetings are encouraged
- Our ACTG June Network Meeting is Postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. At this
 time, we are determining how to best proceed with this meeting. We will keep you the
 GCAB reps appraised as to whether we will hold an in-person meeting in the fall 2020
 (at the earliest) or hold this meeting virtually. Please do not make any plans to attend
 the June meeting. At this time, our priority is the safety and health of our site CAB's,
 Network staff and our trial participants as the situation evolves, we will update you
- Thursday March 26, 2020 GCAB call will cover how sites monthly CAB meeting can take place using virtual technology
