	Large rounded and dominant letters (the letters that are on the dotted lines)	Friendly, sociable
	Letters slope to the left (backwards)	Introvert
	Letters are straight up and down	Neither introvert or extrovert
	Words slope up by the end of the line	Optimistic, cheerful
	Words slope down by the end of the line	Physically or mentally tired
	Flowing writing (linked letters and linked words)	Eager, impulsive
	Space between letters and words (few linked letters and no linked words)	Thoughtful, considerate
	Completely separated letters	Artistic
	Words with little space between them	Social
	Words with large spaces between them	Comfortable being alone
	Fancy letters (decoration)	Desire to be noticed
	Unfinished words	Intelligent, impatient
	Large, broad upper loops on letters	Emotional
	Lower loops on letters that lean to the right	Interested in others
	Upper parts of letters that lean to the left	Fond of the past
	Uneven upper loops on letters	Changeable, disillusioned
	Lower loops that are full and lean to the left	Physically fulfilled
	Closed letter “e” and other small closed loops	Secretive
	“s” at the ends of words stand alone	Independent
	Letters not completely connected	Casual nature
	“i” without the dot and “t” without the cross	Forgetful, careless
	Dot directly above the “i”	Exacting
	Dot ahead of the “i”	Active, thinking
	Dot of the “i” has a flick	Sense of humor
	Dot before the “i”	Thoughtful
	Dot on “i” is in different positions	Distracted
